ORDINANCE NO. 2025-03**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF TITLE VI, SECTION I,
GENERAL LICENSING PROVISIONS**

The City Council of the City of East Gull Lake ordains as follows:

SECTION I. Amendment. Title VI, Section I, Section 6.1- 2, Application for License is amended as follows. The deleted language is shown with strikethrough and the added language is underlined:

....

3. Renewal of ~~a an annual~~ license may be granted to a licensee in good standing on the basis of the original application, unless otherwise provided. However, if a request for renewal is not submitted to the City Clerk or other authorized official within 21 days after the date of expiration for the preceding license, the applicant must fill out an original application.

SECTION II. Amendment. Title VI, Section I, Section 6.1- 4, Date and Duration of License is amended as follows. The deleted language is shown with strikethrough and the added language is underlined:


Date and Duration of License. Unless state law or City Code otherwise provides for a different term or duration of a license, the term of a city-issued license shall be 12 calendar months and shall not be valid beyond either the earlier of the expiration date specified therein and, unless otherwise provided, shall not extend beyond or December 31 of the year issued. ~~However, For annual licenses that expire at the end of a calendar year, those at any time after December 1,~~ licenses may be issued at any time after December 1 of that calendar year, for the next calendar year. Unless otherwise specified, the full annual fee will be required of licensees irrespective of the date of issuance of the license.

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY. Every section, provision and part of this ordinance is declared severable from every other section, provision and part thereof. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance is held to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not invalidate any other section, provision or part of this ordinance.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
