

## Resolution 03:01-22

### Reestablishing Precincts and Polling Places

WHEREAS, the legislature of the State of Minnesota has been redistricted; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute section 204B.14, subd. 3 (d) requires that precinct boundaries must be reestablished within 60 days of when the legislature has been redistricted or at least 19 weeks before the state primary election, whichever comes first;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of East Gull Lake, County of Cass, State of Minnesota hereby reestablishes the voting precinct boundary of City of East Gull Lake. A map of the boundary is on file. The resolution will be filed with the Cass County Auditor-Treasurer as notice of precinct boundary reestablishment as required by law.

FURTHER, we verify that the voting precinct meets all federal and state statutory requirements. Voters will vote:

East Gull Lake City Hall, 10790 Gull Point Rd, East Gull Lake, MN

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Cass County Auditor-Treasurer is hereby authorized on behalf of City of East Gull Lake to submit these reestablished voting precinct boundaries to the Minnesota Secretary of State and others as required by law.


Attached to this resolution, for illustrative purposes, is a map showing said precincts and the location of each polling place.
